Mining/Surface – Coal – General Safety

### **General Safety** **30 CFR 77.1710**

Reference Interagency Agreement between the Mine Safety and Health Administration U.S. Department of Labor and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration U.S. Department of Labor. Many MSHA and OSHA standards and requirements are identical in nature and there may be some overlap in enforcement of standards.

When working as an operator in the capacity of an independent contractor performing services or construction at a facility that falls under MSHA standards, the provisions of our safety program apply except as modified below:

In compliance with MSHA standard 30 CFR 77.1710(i), seatbelts will be worn in mobile equipment or vehicles where there is a danger of overturning and where roll protection is provided.

All contractors working on mine operator property, even when accompanied by operator personnel, must check in and check out on a daily basis.

To ensure our personnel are properly accounted for, we will follow the check in and check out procedures established by the mine operator for whom we are working.
