Well Control – Off Shore

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Per 30 CFR Subpart O, the tasks which must be only performed by or under the supervision of an employee who has had well control training includes those which are directly related to **drilling, well completion, well workover, and well servicing operations**. For purposes of this subpart, well completion/well workover means those operations following the drilling of a well that are intended to establish or restore production to a well. It includes **small tubing operations** but does not include well servicing. Well servicing means **snubbing, coil tubing, and wireline operations**.

Job Titles of employees who require well control training include and who will or will have the potential to perform tasks directly related to drilling, well completion, well workover, snubbing, coil tubing, and wireline operations are: Toolpusher, Superintendent, and Drilling Foreman; Derrickman, Assistant Driller, and Driller; Floorman, Derrickman.

Because MMS requires that each operator develop a company-specific compliance program and compliance programs may vary significantly from operator to operator, we will ensure that our employees are trained in the compliance program developed by the operator for whom we are working.
